This interactive presentation will explore the effects of changing childhoods and limited outdoor risky play time on children's health and development, as well as strategies to restore balance.

Dr. Mariana Brussoni is Associate Professor at the University of British Columbia, and investigator with BC Children's Hospital Research Institute and the BC Injury Research & Prevention Unit. Mariana investigates child injury prevention, including developmental importance of children's risky play.
